

#### The Morgan Family Story

In summer 2018, Jeremy Morgan was expecting to have a typical work week in Florida while his wife took their three children on vacation to Hershey, PA. Not long into their trip, his family faced a crisis that no family should have to experience while so far away from home.

While spending the day at Hersheypark, Jeremy's seven-year-old son, Adrian, started experiencing severe stomach pain. The family rushed Adrian to Penn State Health Children's Hospital to figure out what was wrong. Jeremy hopped on a plane as fast as he could to be there for his son and family.

"When I got there, the family hadn't slept for almost a day and a half," Jeremy said. "My wife and all three kids were sprawled out on the chairs in the Emergency Room."

Jeremy quickly stepped in and started juggling his family's needs—getting them a room in a nearby hotel and lugging the kids and their belongings back and forth to the hospital. Jeremy recalls it being "a huge mess."

After a day of trying to maintain this balancing act, one of the nurses suggested that Jeremy call the Ronald McDonald House across the street. Within a few hours the RMH found an opening for the Morgan's and got them settled in.

"Coming from so far out of town, and going through everything we were juggling, the RMH all of the sudden gave us hope," Jeremy said. "It gave us the balance to get our personal needs taken care of—our laundry done, our meals made—and we were able to focus more on our son."

The doctors found that part of Adrian's intestine had slid into another adjacent section of his intestine, and his condition required surgery.

The Morgan family stayed for a total of three nights at the RMH while Adrian underwent surgery for his intestinal issues.

Though their stay was shorter than the average family stay at the RMH, Jeremy remembers it being a "saving grace" and "an incredible experience." He recalled the feeling of getting recharged between visits to the hospital, eating home-cooked meals, and having access to laundry services was amazing for his family at that time.

"It was very refreshing to experience an organization that worked so hard to anticipate the needs of families so thoroughly," Jeremy said. "All of our needs were taken care of and I am so thankful."

Adrian is now 10 years old and doing great!

"The support that the Ronald McDonald House gave my family will never be forgotten," Jeremy said. "At a time of dire need, they were able to provide support that we didn't even know we would need until we were faced with this emergency situation."
