Patrick has been coming to Hershey since he was 2 days old when he was born with kidney failure. We were familiar with Ronald McDonald House concept because the Scranton House is only a few blocks from our home.

We were at the RMH when the new section opened in 2009. That same year, there was no way we could make Christmas happen. We put together a small stocking to give him and he said, "I thought there might be more but I guess I already got my really big present," (as he patted his belly). He went into the bathroom to wash up and came out screaming, "He came, he came! Santa really came!" Thanks to the RMHC-CP and generous donors, the tub was filled with toys!

Over the years, Ronald McDonald House Charities of Central Pennsylvania has been a Godsend for our family. Having a chronically ill child is incredibly stressful, and the House and hospital support have gone a long way in making our lives a little more bearable. We give back where we can, making a house meal, and doing TV commercials, but more importantly, spreading the word.

This is a place with loving, caring people that can make a family's fight just a little less desperate at a time when it feels like all hope is lost. Something as simple as a friendly smile, a cup of coffee, or a hot meal can refresh a parent, can give them a little strength when they need it most. There is a warm, comfortable bed to recharge, *because a burned-out parent can't* help their child as well as a well-rested one. The occasional puppy to pet or kitty to scratch can help to plant a smile on the face of a scared child, or their frazzled parents. The House is the place for that to happen.

There are simply no words to express the gratitude that we feel. A hot meal, a roof over our heads, a snack or cookie, basic living supplies, it is all needed, and a simple "thank you" just doesn't seem like enough.

# OTHER WAYS to get involved



**GUEST CHEF PROGRAM:** Guest chef program consists of no more than 6 people and participants must be 16 years of age or older. Must cook the meal in our kitchen or another commercial kitchen.



**COME IN & BAKE:** For individuals 16 years old and over, we offer a baking program here at the House from 1 to 3 p.m. on Tuesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday. We have a limit of TWO bakers in the kitchen at one time.



**VOLUNTEER AT THE HOUSE:** Weekly or bi-weekly four hour shifts. Shifts are daily from 9AM-1PM or 1-5PM and 5-9PM. Must be 18 years or older.



**SPECIAL EVENTS:** RMHC of Central PA hosts several special events each year. Help is needed with event operations, setup and tear down.
